DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

**PUGET SOUND PARTNERSHIP  
ACTION AGENDA**

**Description of Proposal:** Adoption of the Puget Sound Partnership Action Agenda. The Action Agenda includes programs, policies, projects, and other activities needed to achieve a healthy Puget Sound ecosystem by 2020. The Action Agenda is scheduled for adoption on December 1, 2008.

Implementation of the Action Agenda, contingent on legislative action where necessary, will follow. Some actions are proposed to begin in 2009 and other actions will be phased in later. Some future actions will likely be subject to additional environmental review by the agencies responsible for taking the actions.

**Location of Proposal:** The Action Agenda covers all of Puget Sound and its associated uplands and watersheds.
