





Key Strategic Questions

- What are the key outcomes in our first four years? What does initial success look like?
- Do you concur with the criteria for priority setting?
 - Action has regional or ecosystem impact
 - No entity is currently leading work or more support is needed to advance it
 - Action will likely not happen if not advanced by the Partnership
 - Action lays the foundation for future investment or activities.
- Stormwater is the #1 threat facing Puget Sound, yet it lacks a comprehensive strategy to address it. Does it make sense to elevate stormwater as our initial focus?



Key Questions: Sections A - D

- How can we avoid over reaching or under delivering?
- Are the priorities achievable in 2 – 4 years?
- Are there priorities missing?
- Do these go far enough? Are they bold enough?



Key Questions: Funding

- Is a new revenue stream a near-term priority or a long-term priority?
- How do we develop a strategy that shares the funding burden among local-state-federal sources?
- Where/how does private funding fit?
- Assuming funding resources will not be enough, how do we target investments across priorities?
