Summary: The Partnership is working toward setting some ecosystem, threat reduction and restoration targets for 2020. The updated short list of targets to investigate first for target setting include:

Ecosystem	Threats or restoration
Orca	Shoreline alteration reduction
Chinook	Surface water runoff (pollutants, volume)
Herring	Growth direction
Lowland forest cover	Acres of shellfish beds reopened
Eelgrass	Acres of estuarine habitat restored
	Swimming beaches

Staff will discuss an updated process and schedule with the Leadership Council.

Background: Earlier in 2010, the Leadership Council expressed strong desire to set 2020 targets in 2010. The Cross-Partnership workgroup, Ecosystem Coordination Board (ECB), and Science Panel have weighed in on targeting setting and a short list of ecosystem and threat reduction targets to investigate first was developed in March 2010.
